LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

Fiscal and Planning Committee Report June 25, 1990

Committee Vote: Favorable, 5-0 (In favor Council Members Castaldi,

Casula, MacKinnon, Pemberton, and Wilson).

This resolution will amend the Salary Plan of the County to reflect the terms of the labor agreement for the Uniformed Civilian Bargaining Unit.
