WHEREAS	S, on June 8, 2010, the Prince George's County Council, sitting as the District
Council for that	portion of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's
County ("Distric	t Council"), approved the Prince George's County Historic Sites and Districts
Plan; a functiona	al master plan as defined in Section 27-107.01(a); and
WHEREAS	S, the 2010 Prince George's County Historic Sites and Districts Plan provides
that historic sites	s must meet specific criteria for historic, cultural, archeological and/or
architectural sign	nificance found in Subtitle 29-104 of the County Code; and
WHEREAS	S, the Old Marlboro Primary School, located at 14554 Elm Street, Upper
Marlboro, was d	esignated as Historic Site 79-019-51 in the 2010 Prince George's County
Historic Sites an	d Districts Plan; and
WHEREAS	S, on July 23, 2019, the District Council adopted CR-72-2019 for the purpose of
initiating a mino	r amendment process to amend the 2010 Prince George's County Historic Sites
and Districts Pla	an to remove the Old Marlboro Primary School (Historic Site 29-019-51) and the
Old Marlboro Hi	igh School (Historic Site 79-019-52) from the Inventory of Historic Resources;
and	
WHEREAS	S, the Prince George's County Planning Board of the Maryland-National Capital

Park and Planning Commission ("Planning Board"), in conjunction with the Prince George's

County Council, pursuant to Section 27-642 of the Zoning Ordinance of Prince George's County, held a duly advertised public hearing on the Minor Amendment to the 2010 *Prince George's County Historic Sites and Districts Plan*, on September 17, 2019, in order to receive public comment into the record on the proposed minor amendment; and

WHEREAS, after the close of the public hearing record, planning staff prepared a Technical Staff report analyzing the proposed amendment and public hearing comments with recommendation to the Planning Board for consideration; and

WHEREAS, on October 10, 2019, the Planning Board held a public work session on the minor amendment to examine the analysis of testimony presented at the September 17, 2019 joint public hearing and exhibits received before the close of the public record on October 2, 2019 and subsequently, pursuant to Section 27-642(e) of the Zoning Ordinance of Prince George's County, the Planning Board recommended approval of the amendment via PGCPB No. 19-119; which included the Technical Staff Report as an attachment; and

WHEREAS, on October 29, 2019, the District Council conducted a public work session to examine the record of joint public hearing testimony and recommendations of Planning Board regarding the proposed minor amendment; and

WHERAS, after a presentation by staff on the public hearing testimony and Planning Board recommendation, the Council voted favorably to direct staff to prepare a Resolution of approval of the proposed minor amendment and reflecting the Council Committee of the Whole direction in its favorable report on the proposed minor amendment on October 29, 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that in accordance with Sections 27-642 of the Zoning Ordinance, the following Minor Amendment to the 2010 *Prince George's County Historic Sites and Districts Plan*, is hereby approved and incorporated as set forth fully within this Resolution an, and summarized below:

MINOR AMENDMENT:

Amend the 2010 *Prince George's County Historic Sites and District Plan* to remove the Old Marlboro Primary School, Historic Site 79-019-51, and the Old Marlboro High School, Historic Site 79-019-52, as described in Attachment A, and incorporated fully herein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any proposal for redevelopment of the subject property

seek to retain historic building fabric from the two school buildings to the extent practicable and to commemorate the history of the property through interpretive signage or other visual elements; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Dr. William and Sarah Beanes Cemetery (Historic Site 79-019-22) be preserved in place and protected from any redevelopment of the subject property, including though delineation of an appropriate environmental setting; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Council shall transmit a copy of this Resolution to the Prince George's County Planning Board of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission in accordance with procedural requirements of Section 27-642 of the Zoning Ordinance.
