prepare a study	of data center buildings and uses and their impact on the County and its residents	
including, but no	ot limited to, issues such as transportation; demands on energy, water, sewer and	
other public and	private utilities; environmental impacts, employment, and tax revenue.	
WHEREA	S, the Mid-Atlantic Region of the United States is experiencing significant data	
center growth driven by robust fiber infrastructure, proximity to Washington D.C., and high		
demand from m	ajor tech companies; and	
WHEREA	S, the development of data centers is leading to substantial increases in power	
usage and capac	ity needs which can strain local power grids, require large amounts of water for	
cooling, and pot	entially contribute to noise pollution while also offering economic benefits like	
job creation and	tax revenue; and	
WHEREA	S, understanding the impacts of this relatively new industry on Prince George's	
County and its r	esidents and businesses is important in determining how to best regulate and	
encourage the ap	oppropriate development of data centers to promote the public health, safety, and	
welfare; and		
WHEREA	S, the Prince George's County Planning Department of the Maryland-National	
Capital Park and	Planning Commission is best suited to undertake this study and report back to	

the County Council;
