**RESOLUTION**

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 School Facilities Surcharge

3 For the purpose of adjusting the school facilities surcharge for inflation for Fiscal Year 2011,  
4 beginning July 1, 2010, as required by State law.

5 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 10-192.01(a) of the Prince George's County Code, the  
6 County Council, by ordinance, shall impose a school facilities surcharge on new residential  
7 construction for which a building permit is issued on or after July 1, 2003; and

8 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 10-192.01(b)(1)(A) of the Prince George's County Code  
9 for Fiscal Year 2004, a school facilities surcharge imposed on a single-family detached dwelling,  
10 townhouse, or dwelling unit for any other building containing more than a single dwelling unit  
11 shall be in the amount of \$12,000; except the amount shall be \$7,000 if the building is located  
12 between Interstate Highway 495 and the District of Columbia; and \$7,000 if the building is  
13 included within a Basic Plan or Conceptual Site Plan that abuts an existing or planned mass  
14 transit rail station site operated by the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority; and

15 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 10-192.01(b)(1)(B) of the Prince George's County Code,  
16 for Fiscal Year 2005 and each succeeding fiscal year, the facilities surcharge established in  
17 subparagraph (A) of this paragraph shall be adjusted for inflation in accordance with the  
18 Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers published by the United States Department of  
19 Labor, for the fiscal year preceding the year for which the amount is being calculated; and

20 WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 26 of the 2003 Laws of Prince George's County,  
21 beginning in Fiscal Year 2005, the County Council, by resolution, shall adjust the surcharge each  
22 year by the percentage change in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers published

1 by the United States Department of Labor from the previous fiscal year; and

2 WHEREAS, the percentage change in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers  
3 published by the United States Department of Labor, from April 2009 to April 2010, the most  
4 recent published data for the preceding fiscal year, is an increase of 2.2%, and results in an  
5 increase of \$179 above the Fiscal Year 2010 school facilities surcharge of \$8,120 for permits  
6 issued for buildings between Interstate Highway 495 and the District of Columbia and for  
7 permits issued for buildings included within a basic plan or conceptual site plan that abuts an  
8 existing or planned mass transit rail station site operated by the Washington Metropolitan Area  
9 Transit Authority and an increase of \$306 above the Fiscal Year 2010 school facilities surcharge  
10 of \$13,921 for permits issued for all other buildings.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's  
12 County, Maryland, that for Fiscal Year 2011, the school facilities surcharge shall be \$8,299 for  
13 permits issued for buildings located between Interstate Highway 495 and the District of  
14 Columbia and for permits issued for buildings included within a basic plan or conceptual site  
15 plan that abuts an existing or planned mass transit rail station site operated by the Washington  
16 Metropolitan Area Transit Authority and \$14,227 for permits issued for all other buildings, be  
17 and the same is hereby approved, effective July 1, 2010.
