RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

Recovery Zones

For the purpose of designating Prince George's County as a Recovery Zone for purposes of issuance of Recovery Zone Economic Development Bonds and Recovery Zone Facility Bonds.

WHEREAS, in order to provide certain incentives to promote job creation and economic recovery in areas particularly affected by employment decline, the Congress of the United States enacted the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, Pub. L. No. 115-5, 123 Stat. 115 (2009) ("ARRA"), which became effective on February 17, 2009; and

WHEREAS, ARRA includes provisions authorizing state and local governments and issuing authorities empowered to issue bonds on behalf of state and local governments to issue certain Recovery Zone Bonds (as defined in ARRA), which include Recovery Zone Economic Development Bonds (as defined in ARRA) and Recovery Zone Facility Bonds (as defined in ARRA); and

WHEREAS, ARRA provides that a "Recovery Zone" means (i) any area designated by the issuer as having significant poverty, unemployment, rate of home foreclosures, or general distress; (ii) any area designated by the issuer as economically distressed by reason of the closure or realignment of a military installation pursuant to the Defense Base Closure and Realignment Act of 1990; and (iii) any area for which a designation as an empowerment zone or renewal community is in effect as of the effective date of ARRA; and

WHEREAS, Prince George's County, Maryland (the "County") has been allocated initial volume cap under ARRA whereby it can issue up to \$27,691,000 in Recovery Zone Economic Development Bonds within the meaning of Section 1400U-2 of ARRA; and

WHEREAS, the Recovery Zone Economic Development Bonds will provide a cost effective source of funds for the purpose of promoting development or other economic activity within the area of the County designated as the Prince George's County Recovery Zone; and

WHEREAS, the County has been allocated initial volume cap under ARRA whereby it can issue up to \$41,537,000 in Recovery Zone Facility Bonds within the meaning of Section 1400U-3 of ARRA; and

WHEREAS, the Recovery Zone Facility Bonds will provide a source of below-market financing for businesses that are located in the Prince George's County Recovery Zone; and

WHEREAS, the Internal Revenue Service recently released Notice 2009-50 which provides guidance for issuance of Recovery Zone Bonds; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to ARRA, the state, county or municipality that receives a volume cap allocation may "make the designations of recovery zones in any reasonable manner as it shall determine in good faith in its discretion"; and

WHEREAS, the County has reviewed home foreclosure and unemployment statistics in the County, as well as the accompanying general economic distress that exists in the County, and has determined to designate the County in its entirety as a Recovery Zone as more fully described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that it finds that Prince George's County meets the criteria set forth in ARRA to be a Recovery Zone.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED for purposes of Section 1400U-1(b) of ARRA, the entire geographic area of Prince George's County is designated as a Recovery Zone as more fully described on Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Recovery Zone Facility Bonds Project Selection Process hereby described in Exhibit "B", is attached hereto and made a part hereof.
