 - (ii) The property is located within 2,500 feet of an existing mass transit rail station operated by the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority (WMATA); and
 - (iii) The property is a State declared environmental brownfield site in excess of 20 acres;
- (B) Development shall be in accordance with the regulations for the R-18C Zone, except the following specific requirements apply:
 - (i) Maximum of 55% Lot Coverage;
 - (ii) Minimum of 45% Green Area;
 - (iii) Minimum 25 feet for distance between unattached multi-family dwellings and courts; and
 - (iv) Bedroom percentages as provided in Section 27-419 shall not apply.
