RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Acting Executive Director of the Minority Business Opportunities Commission
 3 For the purpose of extending the appointment of Floyd E. Wilson, Jr., as Acting Executive
 4 Director of the Minority Business Opportunities Commission.

5 WHEREAS, Section 505 of the Charter of Prince George's County, Maryland, provides for
 6 the County Executive to make a temporary appointment to the position of head of any agency of
 7 the Executive Branch if such a position shall become vacant; and

8 WHEREAS, Section 505 further provides that such appointment may be extended an
 9 additional four calendar months by resolution of the County Council; and

10 WHEREAS, by Executive Order No. 46-2003, Floyd E. Wilson, Jr., was appointed as
 11 Acting Executive Director of the Minority Business Opportunities Commission, effective
 12 December 15, 2003.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
 14 County, Maryland, that the appointment of Floyd E. Wilson, Jr., as Acting Executive Director of
 15 the Minority Business Opportunities Commission be and the same is hereby extended for a
 16 period of up to four calendar months from the date of this resolution.
