## **COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE**

**Committee Vote: Favorable with amendments (9-0)** 

The County Council, acting as the Committee of the Whole, met on July 13, 1999 to consider proposed amendments to the County's Fiscal Year 1999 Capital Budget for the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission. Specifically, CR-29 amends the current Capital Budget for four projects -- The Rural Legacy Reserve Fund, Henson Creek Golf Course, the Fort Washington Area Community Recreation project and the Randall Farm Maintenance Facility. Funding will be provided by the State (Rural Legacy), developer contributions (Henson Creek) and a transfer of available funding from the Commission's FY99 operating Budget (Fort Washington Area Community Recreation project and Randall Farm Maintenance Facility).

The County Executive has endorsed the legislation. Staff has proposed two technical corrections.

The Office of Law noted one technical amendment to make the Resolution retroactive to June 30, 1999.

## BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

This Resolution would amend the Fiscal Year 1998-1999 Capital Budget for the M-NCPPC to provide authorization for the Commission to expend State funds under the Rural Legacy Program, expend a developer contribution for work at the Henson Creek Golf Course, consolidate funding for designing a community center in the Fort Washington/Accokeek area and provide for improvements at the Randall Farm Maintenance Facility.
