WHERE	AS, the Approved FY 2005 Planning Department Work Program requires that a
Sector Plan be pr	epared for the East Glenn Dale area; and,
WHERE	AS, the Sector Plan area being part of Planning Area 70 should generally be
bounded on the n	orth by Good Luck Road, on the east by Springfield Road and Hillmeade Road
on the south by D	Daisy Lane, and on the west by Glenn Dale Boulevard (MD 193); and,

WHEREAS, the Sector Plan will evaluate land use intensity and compatibility that

enhances the quality and character of the community, encourages quality economic development,

preserves and protects environmentally sensitive and scenic lands, and makes efficient use of

existing and proposed County infrastructure and investment for the East Glenn Dale area. The Sector Plan will set development policies consistent with the intent of the 2002 General Plan recommendations for the MD 193 corridor and may develop new zoning tools as necessary to achieve this goal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission is hereby directed to prepare a Sector Plan and a concurrent SMA for the East Glenn Dale area in accordance with the requirements of Parts 3 and 13 of the Zoning Ordinance.
