## BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

The Heights Master Plan and Sectional Map Amendment (SMA) project was initiated in 1996. The District Council and Planning Board held a joint public hearing on the preliminary master plan and proposed sectional map amendment in July 1999.
