RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

The Patuxent River Policy Plan Addendum

For the purpose of adopting the plan as submitted by the Patuxent River Commission and the Maryland Department of State Planning.

WHEREAS, the population within the Patuxent Watershed has increased significantly, resulting in the loss of forest cover, agricultural land and open space, with a corresponding increase in impervious surfaces causing nutrient and sediment pollution of the Patuxent River and

WHEREAS, as a result of the declining condition of the river, economic and recreational resources are less productive; and

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council has worked to improve the quality of water in the Patuxent River; and

WHEREAS, the 1980 Patuxent River Watershed Act required the Department of State Planning to prepare a Patuxent River Policy Plan to be submitted for approval by the seven counties of the watershed, and;

WHEREAS, the Department of State Planning worked closely with county officials in preparation of the plan, and the Patuxent River Commission held public hearings on the plan throughout the watershed; and

WHEREAS, in 1984 Prince George's County and the six other counties in the Patuxent Watershed and the State of Maryland adopted the Patuxent River Policy Plan; and

WHEREAS, in 1988, in accordance with the Patuxent River Policy Plan, the Prince George's County Council adopted CR-13-1988, which directed the preparation of legislation to

establish a Primary Management Area (PMA) for the Patuxent River Watershed of Prince George's County; and

WHEREAS, in 1989, the Prince George's County Council adopted CB-121-1989, which implemented the policy adopted in CR-13-1988 for the management of land use within the Patuxent River watershed and established criteria for stream and wetland buffers; and

WHEREAS, CR-13-1988 also directed that the policies expressed therein shall be considered in the preparation of Master Plans as implemented by Sectional Map Amendments; and

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council subsequently approved Master Plans for those portions of Prince George's County within the Patuxent River Watershed, including the Master Plans for Subregion I, Glenn Dale-Seabrook-Lanham, Bowie-Collington-Mitchellville, Landover and Vicinity, Largo-Lottsford, Subregion VI and Melwood-Westphalia; and

WHEREAS, each of these Master Plans included policies to protect the Patuxent River Watershed in accordance with CR-13-1988 and the Patuxent River Policy Plan; and

WHEREAS, Prince George's County has designated almost 35,000 acres of the Patuxent River Watershed within Prince George's County as a Rural Legacy Area; and

WHEREAS, the Patuxent River Watershed Act calls for periodic review and, if appropriate, revision of the Patuxent River Policy Plan; and

WHEREAS, in November 1997, the Patuxent River Commission, working with County officials and the Maryland Office of Planning, reviewed the Patuxent River Policy Plan, reaffirmed the ten recommendations contained therein, and approved an addendum to the Plan; and

WHEREAS, this addendum and its six key findings are intended to be used in conjunction with the original 1984 plan; and

WHEREAS, the Patuxent River Commission's legislation provides for updating the plan via the amendment process; and

WHEREAS, the County Council expresses support for the overall plan and addendum as a policy framework for guiding our continuing efforts to protect and enhance the Patuxent River and its watershed; and

WHEREAS, it is understood that achievement of the plan's and addendum's goals will require refinement and flexible implementation of its stated policies in order to recognize the

particular local conditions and needs of existing and planned development throughout the watershed; and

WHEREAS, implementation of the plan's and addendum's recommendations for local programs will require additional consideration, public review and local approval; and

WHEREAS, this amended Patuxent River Policy Plan, upon adoption, is to serve as a policy guide for State agencies and local governments in carrying out programs in the watershed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the County Council hereby approves the addendum to the Patuxent River Policy Plan.
