LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

COMMITTEE-OF-THE-WHOLE REPORT

Committee Vote: Favorable as amended, 6-1-0 (In favor: Council Members

Bell, Castaldi, Casula, MacKinnon, Mills and

Pemberton; in opposition: Council Member Wilson)

Staff explained that CB-104-1990 exempts a roof-mounted satellite dish antenna from the requirement for a building permit, provided the antenna requires no mechanical penetration of the roof, and the permissible loading of the roof is not exceeded. It was noted that CB-91-1990, which had just been considered by the Committee, ensures that this type of antenna will be 4 feet or less in diameter, and will not be permitted on a single family dwelling, or any use in a residential zone.

Gary Pudles, representing Muzak, spoke in favor of the legislation.

The legislation was voted out favorably, with a technical amendment, and the effective date was amended to be consistent with the companion legislation, CB-91-1990.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT (Includes reason for proposal, as well as any unique statutory requirements)

The proposed legislation would add language to the Building Code and Section 624.0 of the BOCA Code to cover the installation or erection of a satellite dish antenna on a flat roof.
