Ms. Miriam Brewer, Appointment Liaison, Office of the County Executive, provided a brief overview and introduced the appointees. The Prince George's County Advisory Committee on Aging is comprised of 24 members appointed by the County Executive and confirmed by the County Council to advise them on issues related to aging. The members are citizen leaders representing the public and private community whose mission is to support and advocate the promotion of choice, independence and dignity for all older Prince Georgian's and their families. The Advisory Committee on Aging has oversight of all aging programs.

After discussion, the Prince George's County Council, sitting as the Committee of the Whole, voted the appointments to the Citizen Complaint Oversight Panel favorable, 8-0.
