RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Fiscal Year 2027 Budget Reconciliation

3 For the purpose of reconciling the appropriations approved within the Prince George's County
4 portion of the Fiscal Year 2027 Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission
5 Annual Budget with the Fiscal Year 2027 Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for
6 Prince George's County.

7 WHEREAS, pursuant to Title 18, Land Use Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, the
8 County Council approved the Prince George's County portion of the Fiscal Year 2027 ("FY
9 2027") Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission Annual Budget via enactment
10 of CB-57-2026 ("M-NCPPC Budget"); and

11 WHEREAS, in accordance with the authority conferred by Section 18-106 of the Land Use
12 Article, the County Council appropriated funding to Prince George's County in order to
13 administer the disbursement of support for County services and for qualified non-profit
14 organizations in the County via a Project Charge program ("Project Charges"); and

15 WHEREAS, the approved FY 2027 M-NCPPC Budget included \$4,555,000 million in the
16 Park Fund, \$16,615,000 million in the Recreation Fund, and \$18,149,237 million in the
17 Administration Fund for Project Charges managed and administered by the County; and

18 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 809 of the County Charter, the County Council approved
19 the FY 2027 Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for the County via enactment of
20 CB-58-2026 ("County Budget"); and

1 WHEREAS, the approved County Budget included an increase in declared revenues for FY
2 2027 in an amount of \$39,319,237 million, which reflects the sum of the corresponding
3 appropriations in the Park, Recreation, and Administration Funds within the FY 2027 M-NCPPC
4 Budget for Project Charges; and

5 WHEREAS, by adoption of this Resolution, the Maryland-National Park and Planning
6 Commission ("Commission") shall make an intergovernmental transfer of funding in the amount
7 of \$4,555,000 million in the Park Fund, \$16,615,000 million in the Recreation Fund, and
8 \$18,149,237 million in the Administration Fund, for a total of \$39,319,237 million, to the
9 County Office of Management and Budget for the Project Charges program; and

10 WHEREAS, the County Council has prepared a list of approved Project Charges, set forth
11 in Attachment A, attached hereto and incorporated as if set forth here fully; and

12 WHEREAS, the County will manage and administer the Project Charge program and
13 awards to approved organizations and individuals in accordance with the County's Non-
14 Departmental Grants Process; and

15 WHEREAS, for funding to third-party organizations and individuals, the County shall be
16 responsible for the evaluation of applications for alignment with one of the NRPA 7 dimensions
17 of well-being, determining whether an entity is eligible for grant funding award, and shall
18 thereafter be responsible maintaining any Project Charge program reports in accordance with the
19 County's Non-Departmental Grants Process; and

20 WHEREAS, the County shall provide the Commission with Project Charge program reports
21 as an accounting of the public purposes served annually, or on or before June 30, 2027.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
23 County, Maryland, that proposed funding for the Project Charge program set forth in Attachment
24 A, be and the same is hereby approved.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Commission shall make an intergovernmental
26 transfer in the amount of \$4,555,000 million in the Park Fund, \$16,615,000 million in the
27 Recreation Fund, and \$18,149,237 million in the Administration Fund, for a total of \$39,319,237
28 million, to the County Office of Management and Budget for the Project Charges program.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the FY 2027 intergovernmental transfer funding is due
2 on July 1, 2026, without further action of the County, to include memoranda of understanding, or
3 invoices for reimbursement.

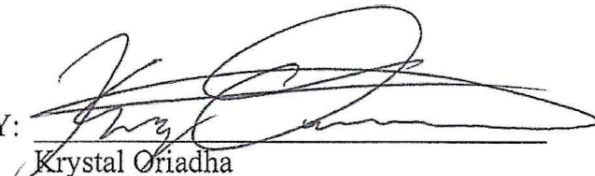
4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County shall provide the Commission with Project
5 Charge program reports as an accounting of the public purposes served annually, beginning on or
6 before June 30, 2027.

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect upon the date of its
8 adoption.

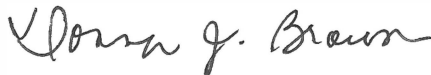
