For the purpose of a	pproving an increase in the additional charge for switched local exchange
access service, com	mercial mobile radio service, and other 911 accessible service within the
County.	
WHEREAS, P	ublic Safety Article, Section 1-301, et seq., Annotated Code of Maryland,
provides for the exis	stence and funding of a 911 System to provide timely and appropriate
assistance when the	lives or property of the citizens of Maryland are in imminent danger; and
WHEREAS, th	nere is currently an additional charge of fifty cents (\$0.50) per month to be
applied to all curren	t bills rendered for switched local exchange access service, wireless
telephone service, o	r other 911 accessible service within the County; and
WHEREAS, a	mendments to the Public Safety Article, Section 1-311 of the Annotated
Code of Maryland,	effective October 1, 2003 authorize the County to increase the 911 additional
charge to seventy-fi	ve cents (\$0.75) per month per bill for switched local exchange access
service, commercial	mobile radio service, or other 911 accessible service within the County; and
WHEREAS, a	dditional expenditures will be required to enhance the capabilities of the 911
system in accordanc	ee with time-sensitive State and Federal mandates for the deployment of
"Phase II Wireless I	Enhanced 911" systems; and
WHEREAS, p	roceeds from the 911 additional charge may only be used to fund the
installation, enhance	ement, maintenance and operation of the County's 911 system; and
WHEREAS, the Public Safety Article, Section 1-311(e) of the Annotated Code of	

Maryland provides that the Public Service Commission shall direct each telephone company that

provides service in a county that imposes an additional charge to add, within 60 days, the full amount of the additional charge to all current bills rendered for switched local exchange access service in the county; and

WHEREAS, within 60 days after a county enacts or adopts an ordinance or resolution that imposes, repeals, or modifies an additional charge, each 911 service carrier that provides service in the county shall add the full amount of the additional charge to all current bills rendered for commercial mobile radio service and other 911 accessible service in the county;

WHEREAS, the County Council conducted a public hearing on November 18, 2003, pursuant to Section 1-311, prior to increasing the 911 additional charge from the charge previously adopted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the 911 additional charge of seventy-five cents (\$0.75) per month per bill for switched local exchange access service, commercial mobile radio service and other 911 accessible service in the County, be and the same is hereby approved, retroactively effective to October 1, 2003.
