assistance for a pr	roject in a designated neighborhood if the application demonstrates that the
project is ready to	proceed when it receives financial assistance; and
WHEREAS	, SYDJUL, LLC, a local small business, has applied with the Neighborhood
BusinessWorks P	rogram for financial assistance with the "Potomac Gourmet Pantry" at National
