**PUBLIC SAFETY AND FISCAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT** Date:6/15/98

Committee Vote: Favorable, 3-0, (In favor: Council Members Wilson, Hendershot and Scott).

This bill will appropriate additional revenue in the amount of \$491,200 from uncommitted and unencumbered fund balance to the Fleet Management Internal Services Fund for FY98. The additional revenue will begin the replacement of fifteen (15) underground fuel tanks before December 1998 as required by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

The Director of Finance has certified, in writing, the availability of the fund balance for this supplementary appropriation.

There should not be any negative fiscal impact on the County as a result of enacting CB-84-1998.
