This resolution will approve the Redevelopment Authority's Statement of Procurement Policy and Procurement Operating Procedures.

These documents were amended and adopted by Board Resolution 2000-3 on October 16, 2000, relating to services of experts and specialists. These procedures are consistent with Section 4, CB-85-1997, of the Council's authorizing legislation.

The Office of Law and the Legislative Officer have reviewed the resolution and find it to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its adoption.

The Council requested that the resolution be amended by including the current Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) and Prevailing Wage requirements.
