EXPLANATION OF ADJUSTMENTS

Department of Social Services

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development awarded \$61,808 for the Continuum of Care (CoC) Planning Project-1. Funding provides for one full-time exempt position to assist with implementation and evaluation of its 10 year plan to prevent and end homelessness.

The Maryland Department of Human Resources awarded \$1,239 in additional funding for the Maryland Emergency Food Program. Funding provides short-term temporary food assistance to eligible clients.

Department of Corrections

The U.S. Department of Justice via the Office of Justice Programs' Bureau of Justice Assistance awarded \$380,214 for the FY 2013 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant- Local Solicitation. Funding provides the County's public safety agencies, i.e., the Police Department, Fire/EMS Department, the Office of the Sheriff and the Office of the State's Attorney with overtime, equipment and technology to reduce crime and promote safety to our citizens.

Office of Homeland Security

The District of Columbia Homeland Security and Emergency Management Agency via the Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI) awarded \$388,862 for the Radio Communications Encryption (MD 5%) Program. Funding provides for the purchase of radio communication encryption equipment that builds and sustains core capabilities to support Prince George's County from regional disasters and emergencies. This is software that will be loaded into existing police radios to provide radio voice encryption. This software is shipped on a dongle that will be used in a device called a key loader. The key loader is attached to the radio allowing the radio to be reprogrammed with voice Advanced Encryption Standard (AES) encryption. Encryption is used for sensitive and secure communications amongst units such as narcotics and special operations.

The District of Columbia Homeland Security and Emergency Management Agency via the Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI) awarded \$400,000 for the Radio Communications Network Fiber Interoperability (MD 5%) Program. Funding provides for the purchase of radio communication network fiber interoperability equipment that builds and sustains core capabilities to support Prince George's County from regional disasters and emergencies. This is part of a larger multi-phase project that will provide County owned dedicated fiber to the new police station, two fire stations, Board of Education headquarters, main radio tower in Upper Marlboro, the Courthouse and the County Administration Building. Specific equipment or fiber purchase is contingent on the phase of the project.

Office of the Sheriff

The District of Columbia Homeland Security and Emergency Management Agency via the Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI) awarded \$125,614 for the Wireless Device Location Service (MD 5%) Program. Funding will enhance the Sheriff's Electronic Surveillance Unit's (ESU) equipment to locate specific wireless devices (mobile phones, etc.). This includes an update of the proprietary software, licensing and the required annual training/certification of appointed personnel charged with operating the ESU equipment.

The Maryland Department of Human Resources, Child Support Enforcement Administration in accordance with the Health and Human Service State plan under Title IV-D of the Social Security Act, awarded \$282,490 in additional funding, thereby increasing the County cash matching funds by \$101,363. Funding will support the specialized unit within the Sheriff's Office responsible for service of process and writs of attachment to persons in arrears with child support payments.

The Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention awarded \$15,050 for the Metal Detectors Program. Funding provides for equipment to identify electronic communication devices and improve current security measures by replacing deficient equipment and supplementing existing security tools with newer and more advanced pieces of technological equipment.

Circuit Court

The Maryland Administrative Office of the Courts through the Office of Emergency Preparedness and Court Security awarded \$156,705 for the FY 2014 Courthouse Security Grant. Funding will provide for security equipment enhancements and installation costs for duress alarms and all associated wiring, control panels and accessories; CCTC cameras and all associated wiring, memory, DVR, servers, monitors and necessary accessories and a protective barrier on file room.

Department of Family Services

The Corporation for National and Community Service awarded \$1,501 in additional funding for the Retired and Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP). Funding supports training and technical assistance activities to develop volunteer service opportunities in County government and with non-profit agencies for approximately 600 older County citizens (55+).

The Maryland Department of Aging awarded \$3,543 in additional funding for the Senior Care Program. Funding provides for coordinated, community-based, in-home services to seniors with disabilities. Senior Care provides "Gapfilling" funds for services for seniors who may be at risk of nursing home placement.

The Maryland Department of Aging awarded \$3,010 in additional funding for the State Guardianship Program. Funding provides for case management services for individuals referred by the courts and for whom the Department's Director has been appointed legal guardian.

The Maryland Department of Aging awarded \$42,392 in additional funding for the Senior Assisted Housing Program. Funding provides for residential living support which includes shelter, meals, housekeeping, personal services and 24-hour supervision to individuals at least 62 years of age who have temporary or periodic difficulties with the activities of daily living and require assistance in performing those personal and household functions. The funds also support coordinating activities necessary to approve facilities for certification and for monitoring visits.

The Maryland Department of Aging awarded \$10,370 in additional funding for the Vulnerable Elderly Program which decreased the county cash contribution. Funding supports the Guardianship Program, which ensures the provision of optimum care/services for adjudicated wards of the court, through professional case management.

The Maryland Department of Aging awarded \$15.00 in additional funding for the Senior Medicare Patrol Program. Funding supports efforts to reduce health insurance fraud by increasing the public's ability to detect and report possible fraud, waste, and abuse. A county cash contribution is no longer required.

The Maryland Department of Health and Mental Hygiene awarded \$317,523 in additional funding for the Mental Health Services Program. Funding provides long-range planning for mental health services, needs assessments and the development of alternative resource providers. Additionally, these funds provide for grants to public or private providers to service targeted populations.

The Governor's Office for Children (GOC) awarded a total of \$35,000 for the community needs assessment and strategic plan program. Funding provides for gathering information regarding community strengths, programs, resources and services to identify results and indicators to prioritize and develop a strategic plan.

The Maryland Department of Juvenile Services awarded \$70,000 in additional funding for the Children In Need Of Supervision (CINS) Diversion Program. Programming helps to divert status-offending youth from deeper involvement with the Maryland Department of Juvenile Services (DJS) by engaging youth and their families, assessing their needs and linking them with community-based treatment providers to address the issues that have resulted in DJS involvement.

Health Department

The Maryland State Department of Education, Division of Special Education/Early Intervention Services under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act and the Consolidation Local Implementation Grant awarded \$220,848 in additional funding to the Infants and Toddlers Program. The Infants and Toddlers Program provides families with early intervention services targeted to infants and toddlers who have a developmental delay, a diagnosed condition (i.e. Down Syndrome, Austin, or Cerebral Palsy) or who may be at risk for developmental delay as a result of a high-risk condition.

The Maryland Department of Health and Mental Hygiene awarded an additional \$30,000 for the Immunization Action Grant. This program provides immunization services to County uninsured children and maintains the current level of morbidity from vaccine preventable diseases.

The Maryland Department of Health and Mental Hygiene awarded an additional \$2,100 for the Babies Born Healthy Initiative. This initiative's focus is to improve access to perinatal services, reduce the infant mortality rate and improve pregnancy outcomes for at-risk women in the County through the provision of comprehensive women's health care.

The United States Department of Health and Human Services, Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) through the Maryland Department of Health and Mental Hygiene awarded \$33,000 for the Oral Health Program. Funding is provided to improve the oral health of Maryland residents. Services will be provided via the Deamonte Driver Dental Van.

The Maryland Department of Health and Mental Hygiene awarded an additional \$287,450 for the AIDS Case Management Program to provide medical case management for those infected with HIV including retaining clients in care. Medical case management provides the necessary support services to clients such as connecting them to social services, assisting with housing needs, transportation for medical appointments and emergency financial assistance to improve health outcomes.

The Maryland Department of Health and Mental Hygiene awarded an additional \$1,000 for the Hepatitis B Prevention Program to provide perinatal services to Hepatitis B infected females who are pregnant or of child bearing age in order to prevent the spread of Hepatitis B to newborn babies and households.

The Maryland Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, Prevention and Health Promotion Administration awarded an additional \$279,888 for the Integration of Sexual Health in Recovery Program. Funding provides for implementation of sexual health framework and rapid HIV testing in substance abuse treatment centers located in the County.

The Maryland Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, Tobacco Implementation Project awarded an additional \$93,371 dedicated to reducing and ultimately eliminating tobacco use and exposure in the County among youth and other minority groups including women. This program works with private organizations and community based organizations to provide tobacco prevention activities including education and cessation.

The Maryland Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, Alcohol and Drug Abuse Administration awarded an additional \$572,150 for the FY 2013 Recovery Support Service Expansion – Recovery Housing for Women with Dependent Children. Funding will provide recovery housing for women with dependent children. Funding will also support activities such as: educational/vocational counseling, family, recovery planning, life skills and social/recreational activities at the Adolescent Clubhouse.

The Maryland Department of the Environment awarded an additional \$12,000 for the Bay Restoration (Septic) Fund. Funding provides for on-site sewage disposal system upgrades using the best available technology for nitrogen removal.

The Office of the Health Officer received an award in the amount of \$52,000 as a sub-recipient from the Institute for Public Health Innovation funded through the 2012 Prevention and Public Health Funds, Center for Disease Control and Prevention Community Transformation Grant.

Funding will support the salary for a limited term grant funded position to assist with promoting the work of the Transforming Neighborhoods Initiative (TNI).

Fire/EMS Department

The District of Columbia Homeland Security and Emergency Management Agency through the FY 2013 Urban Areas Security Initiative awarded \$105,000 for the Chemical, Biological, Radiological, Nuclear and Explosives (CBRNE) Investigations Equipment Project. Funding will be used to upgrade the lighting on the incident response vehicle, the upgrade of the camera system in the command unit, and the purchase of a skid loader to excavate post-blast scenes.

The District of Columbia Homeland Security and Emergency Management Agency through the FY 2013 Urban Areas Security Initiative awarded \$45,000 for the Chemical, Biological, Radiological, Nuclear and Explosives (CBRNE) Special Events Equipment Project. Funding will provide for the purchase of equipment essential for use in the event of a CBRNE incident at the County's FedEx Field. Equipment purchased will include two stretchers, a trailer to transport equipment, and two specialized vehicles to transport equipment and personnel.

The State of Maryland Department of Public Works awarded \$250,000 for the Prince George's Volunteer Fire Department (VFD) Facilities Grant. Funding will support apparatus payments and the renovation and/or repair to VFD facilities in the County.

Police Department

The Maryland Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention through the Cal Ripken, Sr. Foundation awarded \$23,000 for the Badges for Baseball Program. This program is a multifaceted crime prevention and mentoring program that conveys the tenets of "The Ripken Way" to young people through a variety of programs, including Healthy Choices, Healthy Children and baseball themed activities. Funding will allow 50 youth to participate in all aspects of the Badges for Baseball program.

The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration through the Maryland Highway Safety Office awarded additional funding in the amount of \$4,230 for the Traffic Safety Program. Funding provides for support to reduce motor vehicle collisions, injuries and death in the County through education and enforcement.

Office of the State's Attorney

The Maryland Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention, Byrne Justice Assistance Grant awarded \$68,080 for the Simplified and Secure E-Discovery Project. This program will provide assistance to reduce existing gaps in services by making data/file sharing more efficient and foster greater collaboration and cooperation among partner agencies and stakeholders in the legal community throughout Maryland.

Department of Housing and Community Development

The County's General Fund will contribute \$39,995 for the Neighborhood Conservation Initiative 4 (NCI4) to support 10% of six staff total salaries and fringe benefits supporting the program. The NCI provides down payment and closing cost assistance, property acquisition for rehabilitation, and homeownership counseling to qualifying homebuyers.

The County's General Fund will contribute \$263,967 to the National Mortgage Settlement Program to support 66% of six staff total salaries and fringe benefits supporting the program. Program activities will include preventive measures, such as counseling and financial literacy; intervention measures such as outreach, mediation, mortgage assistance; and stabilization measures, such as, acquisition, rehabilitation, and resale of foreclosed properties and down payment and closing cost assistance.
