### REPORT:

Committee Vote: Favorable, 4-0 (In favor: Council Members Lehman, Turner, Taveras, and Davis)

Staff provided a summary of the resolution and referral comments that were received. CR-61-2016 expresses approval of the project and application submitted by the Housing Initiative Partnership (HIP), to the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development for Community Legacy Program Funds in the amount of \$500,000, for the Kentland/Palmer Park Acquisition and Rehabilitation Project. This project will improve habitability and energy efficiency of the County's housing stock by acquiring and rehabilitating 4 (four) vacant and or distressed homes in the Kentland/Palmer Park area, which is a Transforming Neighborhood Initiative area (TNI).

Maryann Dillon, Director of the Housing Initiative Partnership (HIP) answered Committee members' questions and provided testimony in support of the resolution.

The Office of Law determined that CR-61-2016 was in proper legislative form and without legal impediments to its adoption.

The Office of Audits and Investigation indicated there will be no adverse fiscal impact on the County as a result of adopting CR-61-2016.
