WHEREAS, Sect	ion 21A-119 of the Prince George's County Code provides that the
Revenue Authority of l	Prince George's County may propose one or more projects for inclusion in
the Authority's Capital	Improvement Program and that the County Executive shall transmit to the
County Council for its	approval by resolution or ordinance any such project approved by the
County Executive; and	
WHEREAS, the O	Capital Improvement Program for the Revenue Authority includes one (1)
mixed-use developmen	at project and three (3) parking projects. The Suitland Scattered Sites
Project (4.91.0003), the	e Hyattsville Justice Center Garage (4.91.0004), the University of
Maryland (UM) Capita	al Region Medical Center Garage (4.91.0005), and the Commercial
Vehicle Parking (CVP)	Lot (4.91.0009). The Suitland Workforce Housing Building K Project
(4.91.0006) and the Su	itland Mixed Use – Building A&B (4.91.0007) were deleted and
combined into the Suit	land Scattered Sites Project in FY 2026. Three (3) projects, the Suitland
Scattered Sites Project	(4.91.0003), the Hyattsville Justice Center Garage (4.91.0004), and the
University of Maryland	d (UM) Capital Region Medical Center Garage (4.91.0005) are in the

Program but not funded in Fiscal Year 2026. The Commercial Vehicle Parking (CVP) Lot (4.91.0009) project is funded for Fiscal Year 2026. Project descriptions are included in the Capital Improvement Program for Fiscal Years 2026-2031 of the Revenue Authority, attached hereto as Attachment 1; and

WHEREAS, the Capital Budget for Fiscal Year 2026 equals One Million dollars (\$1,000,000); and

WHEREAS, Section 21A-118 of the Prince George's County Code provides that if the proposed operating budget of the Authority includes any item to be funded from payments to be received from the County that the anticipated receipts shall be identified for each item and a copy of the proposed budget shall be transmitted by the Authority to the County Executive and the County Council for their review and comment; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has forwarded its proposed operating budget to the County Executive and the County Council for review and comment, as shown in Attachment 2.

SECTION 1. BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that subject to and in accordance with the authority of the Charter of Prince George's County and pursuant to Subtitle 21A of the Prince George's County Code, the Capital Improvement Program for Fiscal Years 2026-2031 of the Revenue Authority of Prince George's County, as submitted by the County Executive to the County Council, a copy of which is attached hereto as Attachment 1 and incorporated herein by reference as though it was set forth fully herein, is hereby authorized, approved, and adopted.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Council has reviewed the proposed Fiscal Year 2026 Operating Budget of the Revenue Authority of Prince George's County and concurs with the proposed Operating Budget for the Revenue Authority as reflected in Attachment 2.
