(a) No subdivisi	ion plat or plan of development (however designated) shall be approved
that provides for a pri	vate road, right-of-way, or easement as the means of vehicular access to
any lot, and no build	ding permit shall be issued for the construction of any building in a
subdivision unless suc	h building is to be located on a lot or parcel of land having frontage on and
direct vehicular access	to a public street, except as hereinafter provided.

1	(b) The Planning Board may approve plats and plans of development containing private
2	roads, rights-of-way, and/or easements under the following conditions:

4	(15) For Use as Part of an Integrated Shopping Center:
5	(A) For land in the C-S-C, M-A-C, M-X-C, or M-X-T Zones, the Planning
6	Board may approve a subdivision with a private right-of-way or easement, provided that:
7	(i) Such right-of-way or easement shall have a minimum right-of-way
8	width of twenty-two (22) feet connecting the lots to a public road;
9	(ii) Such authorization shall be based on a written finding that the private
10	right-of-way or easement is adequate to serve the extent of the development proposed and shall
11	not result in any adverse impact on the access and use of other lots or parcels within the
12	Integrated Shopping Center; and
13	(iii) The development shall comply with all other applicable requirements
14	of this Code.
15	(B) Approval of the right-of-way or easement per this subsection shall be
16	deemed the creation of a driveway in accordance with Part 11 of Subtitle 27.
