RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Licensing of Apprentice Electricians and Journeyman Electricians

3 For the purpose of suspending, temporarily, the requirement pertaining to the licensing of
 4 apprentice electricians and journeyman electricians.

5 WHEREAS, CB-40-2000 was enacted by the County Council on July 25, 2000, and was
 6 signed into law by the County Executive on August 7, 2000, and became effective on September
 7 22, 2000; and

8 WHEREAS, apprentice electricians and journeyman electricians employed by various
 9 public agencies have been unable to obtain appropriate licenses from the Office of Business and
 10 Regulatory Affairs in order to perform electrical work required by their public duties; and

11 WHEREAS, Section 1017(c) of the Charter for Prince George's County, Maryland,
 12 provides that a resolution has the force and effect of law of a temporary or administrative nature.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
 14 County, Maryland, that the provisions of CB-40-2000 that require the licensing of apprentice
 15 electrician and journeyman electricians be and the same are hereby suspended until June 1, 2001.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office of Business and Regulatory Affairs shall
 17 conduct training and outreach activities in conjunction with public sector and private sector
 18 employers to facilitate the testing and licensing of apprentice electricians and journeyman
 19 electricians employed in the County prior to June 1, 2001.
