RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

Well Permit Fees

FOR the purpose of increasing the fee for the inspection of new wells in Prince George's County.

WHEREAS, no new well may be drilled in the State of Maryland except under permit of the State Department of the Environment; and

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Board of Health has been delegated by the State Department of the Environment to implement a well inspection program in Prince George's County;

and

WHEREAS, Section 9-1307(c) of the Environment Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, empowers a County Board of Health so delegated to establish and collect a permit fee of Eighty Dollars (\$80.00) per new well drilled beginning October 1, 1992, excluding test and irrigation wells, prior to issuing a well permit under state law; and

WHEREAS, the County Council for Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the Board of Health for the County, established a well permit fee of Forty Dollars (\$40.00) by CR-58-1983, and now desires to increase the fee to Eighty Dollars (\$80.00) per well in order to help defray the expense of inspecting wells.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the Board of Health for the County, that, effective October 1, 1992, prior to the issuance of a well permit, a fee of Eighty Dollars (\$80.00) shall be collected by the County Health Officer for each well.
