BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that in accordance with the provisions of Section 317 of the Charter, the County Council hereby declares that a public emergency exists affecting the public health, safety, and welfare; said emergency being the need to provide funding to Dimensions Health Corporation in order to support the continuation of essential health services for the citizens and residents of Prince George's County. As the largest provider of inpatient and emergency services, Dimensions Health Corporation is a cornerstone in the health care system in the County. Access to quality health care for the citizens and residents of the County depends on the continuation of Dimensions Health Corporation services. For the past several years, Dimensions Health Corporation has been facing serious financial difficulties resulting in significant operating losses. County funding in Fiscal Year 2004, in the amount of \$5,000,000 is necessary to assist Dimensions Health Corporation with operating costs. Without this supplementary appropriation funding, Dimensions Health Corporation will face increased

1	difficulty in funding vital short-term operating needs that could affect access to care.
