This bill addresses the problem of stolen wheels and rims and gift cards. Secondhand dealers and pawn dealers are required to record a series of information to identify such goods to aid in the decrease of crime. The bill also requires secondhand dealers and pawn dealers to report in RAPIE (Regional Automated Property Information Database) and to pay a fee for such reporting.
