RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Acting Director of the Office of Human Rights

3 For the purpose of extending the temporary appointment of Mr. Jose Villegas, as the Acting
4 Director of the Office of Human Rights.

5 WHEREAS, Section 505 of the Charter of Prince George’s County, Maryland, provides for
6 the County Executive to make temporary appointment to the position of head of an agency of the
7 Executive Branch if such a position shall become vacant; and

8 WHEREAS, Section 505 further provides that such appointment may be extended an
9 additional four months by resolution of the County Council; and


10 WHEREAS, by Executive Order 43-2025, Mr. Jose Villegas, was appointed as Acting
11 Director of the Office of Human Rights, effective September 19, 2025.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George’s
13 County, Maryland, that the temporary appointment of Mr. Jose Villegas as Acting Director of the
14 Office of Human Rights be and the same is hereby extended, for a period of up to four calendar
15 months, beginning November 18, 2025, or until another appointment is made consistent with the
16 Charter of Prince George’s County, Maryland.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
18 Maryland, that the temporary appointment of Mr. Jose Villegas as Acting Director of the Office
19 of Human Rights and the same is hereby extended for a period of up to four calendar months,
20 beginning November 18, 2025.
