RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning
2 Architectural Conservation Districts
3 For the purpose of initiating the preparation of a map and text for an Architectural Conservation
4 Overlay Zone District in the College Park area.

5 WHEREAS, the District Council has determined that the initiation of a map and text for an
6 Architectural Conservation District in the College Park area is appropriate to provide criteria for
7 the preservation of the architectural character of the area; and

8 WHEREAS, the area proposed for the establishment of the College Park Architectural
9 Conservation District is bounded by Maryland Route 193 (Greenbelt Road), Maryland Route 1
10 (Baltimore Boulevard, Maryland Route 410 (East – West Highway) and the CSX Railroad right
11 of way.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
13 County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington
14 Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that the District Council directs the
15 Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission to prepare a map in accordance with
16 the requirements of Part 10A, Division 3, of the Zoning Ordinance for the College Park
17 Architectural Conservation District.
