BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

The Annual Recreational Budget for MNCPP FY 2023-24 was adopted by the approval by CB-62-2023. However, there is a need to fund or increase funding for certain programs and to do so, funding for other programs must be decreased. The proposed changes in funding allocations are as follows: Decrease total funding for District Height Youth Programming (\$250,000), District Heights Senior Programming (\$250,000) and Make Smart Cool (\$20,000); and fund or increase funding for Guns Down Friday (\$50,000), Community on the Frontline (\$100,000), Judge Me Now (\$100,000), Impact One (\$50,000), Shabach Ministries, Inc. (\$100,000), The Heights Community Development Corporation (\$100,000) and Joan's House, Inc. (\$20,000).
