PUBLIC SAFETY & FISCAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT Date: 7/3/96

Committee Vote: Favorable, 4-0 (In favor: Council Members Estepp, Bailey, Maloney and Scott).

This bill will enable the County to borrow an amount not exceeding \$25,128,000 to finance Capital Projects for Public Works and Transportation Facilities and the issuance of such bonds.

The projects are listed on page 2, lines 5-24.

The Council's approval of this bill will allow it to be placed on the fall ballot for voter consideration.

There will be no fiscal impact on the County as a result of enacting CB-42-1996. (However, a negative fiscal impact, to the extent of the debt service obligation incurred by the County when the bonds are sold, will be associated with the enactment of the legislation which authorizes and empowers the County to issue and sell the bonds. The amount of negative fiscal impact cannot be estimated at this time due to the uncertainty of future events).

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

(Includes reason for proposal, as well as any unique statutory requirements)

This bill will authorize Prince George's County, Maryland, to borrow money to finance the design, construction, reconstruction, extension, acquisition, improvement, enlargement, alteration, renovation, relocation, rehabilitation, or repair of Public Works and Transportation Facilities (including Road and Bridges and Mass Transit Facilities).
