PUBLIC SAFETY & FISCAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT Date: 6/7/95

Committee Vote: Favorable, 3-0 (In favor: Council Members Estepp, Maloney and Russell).

This bill will provide for a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$100,837 to the Cable Television Enterprise fund for FY95. The amount of \$75,000 is for the cost associated with the new multi-media center at the PG Community Television Office (PGCTV) and \$25,000 is for the increased cost of rental space. Both amounts are in accordance with an agreement that was reached early in FY95 between PGCTV and the County.

Funding for this legislation will come entirely from unanticipated cable revenues.

The Director of Finance has certified in writing that funds are available for this supplementary appropriation.

There should not be any negative fiscal impact on the County as a result of the enactment of CB-39-1995.

This bill would increase the Approved FY95 budget of the Cable Television Enterprise Fund.
