A RESOLUTION concerning

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the County Council hereby approves the amendments to Salary Schedule Z, Schedule of Pay Grades, submitted and recommended by the County Executive on May 22, 1997, amending Subsection I of the Salary Schedule approved and adopted by CR-63-1995 on November 21, 1995, to read as follows:
