WHEREAS, Section 10	0-241.02 of the Prince George's County Code provides that the
homestead property tax cred	it percentage for the County property tax for the taxable year
beginning July 1, 1999, and	subsequent tax years shall be 102%; and
WHEREAS, Section 9-	105 of the Tax-Property Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland
provides that on or before N	ovember 15 <sup>th</sup> of any year, each county shall set, by law a homestead
property tax credit percentag	ge for the taxable year beginning the following July 1; and
WHEREAS, State law	further provides that if the County does not set a rate, by law, as
required, that the homestead	credit percentage shall be the percentage in effect for the preceding
taxable year; and	
WHEREAS, by CB-10	8-1998, the homestead property tax credit percentage for the
County property tax was last	established at 102%, for the taxable year beginning July 1, 1999;
and	

WHEREAS, Section 817B (d) of the Prince George's County Charter provides for the homestead property tax credit to be set so that it will not exceed 100% plus the percentage of the increase in the Consumer Price Index for the previous twelve months, rounded to the nearest whole number, or 105% whichever is less; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Management and Budget has determined that the increase in the Consumer Price Index for the most recent twelve months, rounded to the nearest whole number is 4%; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive and County Council wish to provide the greatest amount of homestead property tax credit affordable and maintain their pledge to the voters of the County; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the homestead property tax credit percentage for the taxable year beginning July 1, 2001, shall be 104%.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that Section 10-241.02 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby repealed and reenacted with amendments to read as follows:

## SUBTITLE 10. FINANCE AND TAXATION. DIVISION 8. TAX ASSESSMENT, LEVY AND COLLECTION.

Subdivision 5B. Homestead Property Tax Credit.

Sec. 10-241.02. Homestead property tax credit.

(a) Pursuant to Section 9-105(e) of the Tax-Property Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland, the homestead property tax credit percentage for Prince George's County, effective for the taxable year beginning [July 1, 1999] July 1, 2001, shall be [102%] 104%. In subsequent tax years the County Council shall set, by law, by November 15th, the homestead property tax credit percentage for the taxable year beginning the following July 1. The homestead property tax credit percentage shall be no greater than 100% plus the percentage of increase in the Consumer Price Index for the most recent twelve months, rounded to the nearest whole number, but not more than 105%.
