RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 The American Legion

3 For the purpose of expressing the Council’s endorsement of the latest American Legion Post,
4 Warffemius-Seidler Post 381 Baden-Brandywine.

5 WHEREAS, the American Legion (“Legion”) was chartered and incorporated by Congress
6 in 1919 as a patriotic veterans organization devoted to mutual helpfulness; and

7 WHEREAS, the Legion is the nation’s largest wartime veterans service organization with
8 2.4 million members in nearly 14,000 posts throughout America, committed to mentoring youth
9 and sponsorship of wholesome programs in our communities, advocating patriotism and honor,
10 promoting strong national security, and continued devotion to our fellow service members and
11 veterans; and

12 WHEREAS, the latest Legion Post, Warffemius-Seidler Post 381 Baden-Brandywine, has a
13 vision to develop a community based establishment that will be influenced by the leadership of
14 veterans, wounded warriors and retired service members, and which is also supported by
15 educators, community leaders and the residents and citizens of Prince George’s County; and

16 WHEREAS, the Warffemius-Seidler Post 381 Baden-Brandywine is committed to
17 establishing a program that will provide additional educational resources for youth and adults,
18 create employment opportunities for the veterans and residents and citizens of the County, and
19 provide a variety of activities that will support and promote a healthier lifestyle; and

20 WHEREAS, the dedication of the members of Post 381 is a direct reflection of the loyalty,
21 selfless service and commitment of the veterans of our Armed Forces which has contributed to
22 the success of this country; and

1 WHEREAS, the success of Post 381 will be an historical triumph for our County and the
2 County Council’s endorsement is a token of appreciation for their commitment to our residents
3 and citizens.

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
5 County, Maryland, that the County Council endorses the latest American Legion Post,
6 Warffemius-Seidler Post 381 Baden-Brandywine.
