For the purpose of identifying inconsistencies between the Preliminary Largo Town Center

Sector Plan and existing or proposed State or County facilities and approving the inclusion of any new transportation proposals prior to the adoption of the sector plan by the Prince George's

County Planning Board.

WHEREAS, Section 27-645(b)(1) of the County Code requires the Prince George's County Planning Board to submit its proposals for public facilities in the plan to the County Executive and the County Council for identifying any inconsistencies between the preliminary plan and existing or proposed State or County public facilities, including transportation improvements, and in the event of any inconsistences the District Council shall direct the Planning Board on how the inconsistencies shall be eliminated or accommodated within the plan; and

WHEREAS, after consultation with the County Executive, the District Council may also approve, by resolution, public facilities and transportation improvements proposed by the Planning Board for inclusion in the adopted plan; and

WHEREAS, on Thursday, June 6, 2013, the Planning Board transmitted the public facilities element of the Preliminary Largo Town Center Sector Plan (Planning Area 73) for public facilities inconsistencies review and for approval of the inclusion of proposed transportation improvements for planning purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the County Executive, in a letter to the Planning Board dated August 9, 2013, expressed support for the single project recommended in the Public Facilities Referral Report (construction of an extension of Harry S Truman Drive from Largo Town Center Metro Station to Arena Drive) with the understanding that: (1) the project will be built in accordance with County regulations and implemented as frontage improvements similar to other developments throughout the County; and (2) although the County anticipates that responsibility for the proposed improvement be placed with private developers as this line item is not in the current Capital Improvement Plan Budget (CIP), the County is open to further discussions regarding inclusion of this line item in the CIP for this project in the event that the County decides to make substantial public investment currently being considered for the Largo Town Center area; and

WHEREAS, the District Council has concluded that, in general, the new and modified public facilities, including transportation proposals, contained in the Preliminary Largo Town Center Sector Plan are consistent with the County's Capital Improvement Program ("CIP"); and

WHEREAS, the District Council also recognizes that the preliminary sector plan is a long-range plan and some of the proposals go beyond the five-year to six-year time frames of the Consolidated Transportation Program and CIP, respectively.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that the transportation system and public facilities proposals in the public facilities element of the Preliminary Largo Town Center Sector Plan and Proposed Sectional Map Amendment transmitted by the Planning Board on June 6, 2013, set forth in Attachment A and incorporated as if set forth fully herein, be and the same are hereby approved for inclusion in the preliminary plan.
