AN ORDINANCE concerning

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince
George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that
part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's

Ordinance of Prince George's County, Maryland, being also Subtitle
27 of the Prince George's County Code, be and the same are hereby
repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

Sec. 27-459. C-M Zone (Commercial Miscellaneous).

- (a) Purposes
 - (1) The purposes of the C-M Zone are:

(D) To combine concentrations of these uses with those permitted by Section 27-461, uses permitted in the C-S-C Zone, on parcels proximate to the intersection of major arterial roads and of sufficient size, namely a minimum of 30 acres, which two characteristics are hereby deemed to accommodate the combination of those uses permitted in the C-M and C-S-C Zones without being disruptive to the harmonious development, compactness and homogeniety of retail shopping areas.
