One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each violation and eligible for a separate citation for each						
twenty-four (24) hour period such trailer is in violation of this Section.						
SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENAC	CTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby					
declared to be severable; and, in the event that	at any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph
