Clarify if this legislation prohibits possible manufacturing of beneficial end uses of ash, to include brick/ block, pavers, wall board and other cementitious products. If this legislation is intended to allow manufacturing, recommend we restrict inflow of fly ash to the testing levels of pre-processed fly ash to an acceptable and benign manner that meets, at a minimum, the standards associated with Staged Turbulent Air Reactor (STAR) industry standards and/or standards as generated by Maryland Department of the Environment.
