### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:**

Prince George's County, Maryland (the County) and the Deputy Sheriff's Association of Prince George's County, Inc. (DSA) (Civilian Units) have completed labor negotiations on a two-year labor agreement covering Fiscal Years 2025 and 2026. This Bill is to adopt and approve the referenced collective bargaining agreement in accordance with Section 16-233(f) of the Personnel Law.
