MPT Chew- I have a different understanding a COLA is a COLA, a bonus is a bonus and a Merit is a Merit meaning that a bonus is a onetime stipend that you get for outstanding service. A Merit is a percentage you get on top of your salary and becomes part of your salary.

CW Amanda Anderson- TA can we get a copy of the budget I just want to confirm what we have in the budget is correct.

CW Amanda Anderson- The salary for the PSA lead is it coming out to of the budget? **TA Ren**: Yes, we will no longer have a PSA lead position. Instead we are getting a code enforcement contractor from Forest Heights and it will be on a part-time basis or as needed. The cost for this contractor will be paid out of NSD budget.

XIII) Police Department Organizational Chart- (Police Chief Magassouba)

The Administrative Lieutenant will be responsible for the pollicy oversight. That means assisting the Chief of Police with planning of policies and development and management of the Police budget. Approve and track expenditures and coordinate with the Town's finance department, handle human resources and personnel overseeing hiring and onboarding of personnel, conduct administrative investigations and disciplinary review, supervise training programs and certification, record compliance and show compliance the state and federal reporting requirements, oversee eternal audit and policy compliance, manage record and data system.

The Patrol Lieutenant is for patrol oversight, daily patrol operations, and shift scheduling, supervise patrol officers and the Sergeant to ensure visibility. Supervise and response monitor training and direct proactive patrol strategy, respond to major incidents and manage critical scene command. ensure effective response time and public safety covers, personnel, supervision, conduct roll calls, assign duties, and monitor officer performance, review incident reports, and ensure proper case documentations, recommend disciplinary actions or commendations. Will be handing the community stakeholders, attending public meetings, neighborhood watch programs, civil events, addressing citizens' complaints related to patrol service and the operations with the detective special unit that we are trying to bring here the K9 units and dispatch, ensuring readiness of vehicles, equipment, and officers, preparing shift and development skills.

Mayor Pro-Tem- who would be responsible for the gas usage?
Police Chief Maggasouba: That would be the Administrative Lieutenant

CW Faith Ford- Will there be any Resolution for the changes to the organization chart for the changes of the 2 positions?

I motion to move to approve the Chief's request for the Administrative Lieutenant and Patrol Lieutenant, adjusting the current organizational structure of the Police Department, Chief along with the TA, to provide a Resolution for the change along with the budget implications.

CW Amanda Anderson- wants to make sure that we understand that the budget in FY2026 was \$948,000 with the COLA increase and the builder signed and the new structure. It's going to bring us up above \$961,819 in theory, we will be over budget.

Former CW Akers notes from a taxpayers' point of view, Mr. Gibson should have had an incentive program like the Chief, but instead he wanted to give the money he saved from one less staff to the other staff members, as a taxpayer she would rather see more bodies than giving money.

Former CW Akers also expressed that Council member should not send out information from her personal phone to her phone afterhours.
