McCarthy as the Acting Director of the Department of Permitting, Inspections and Enforcement be and the same is hereby extended, for a period of up to four calendar months, beginning May 11, 2023, or until another appointment is made consistent with and the Charter of Prince George's County, Maryland.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the temporary appointment of Mr. Jared M. McCarthy as the Acting Director of Department of Permitting, Inspections and Enforcement be and the same is hereby extended for a period of up to four calendar months, beginning May 11, 2023.
