BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

This resolution approves an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2003 Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission budget. The amendment is in the Prince George's County Planning Department's portion of the budget. Specifically, the resolution authorizes the Planning Department to increase its Geographic Information System (GIS) Special Revenue Fund by

\$358,250. This amount represents Prince George's County Government's, State Highway Administration's and Federal Emergency Management Agency's share of the cost to update the topographic layer with two-foot contours and the planimetric layer.
