




RAB TIMELINE...

- (June 2021) | Preliminary Recommendations To Be Released to Leadership of 3 Branches of Prince George's Co. Government & General Public
- (July & August 2021) | Community Town Halls
- (September – November 2021) | RAB to Meet on Monthly Basis & Incorporate Public Focus Groups
- (December 2021) | Final Recommendations To Be Released

SUBCOMMITTEES**

MOST COMMONLY RAISED RECOMMENDATIONS

- Create a certification process for County non-profits/community-based service providers to become properly vetted as official County Re-entry Partners prioritizing the need for data-tracking methods
- Establish a central, online location for all vetted resources that serve returning citizens
- Increase availability of housing options
- **Support methods of reliable transportation, particularly for employment purposes**
- Expanding the pool of jobs with livable wages available to returning citizens and workforce programs
- Strengthen relationships with the MD DPSCS and DOJ – BOP
- Expanding jail capabilities to allow for space dedicated to addressing mental health/severe mental health needs
- **Make the Bridge Center @ Adam's House more accessible to the general public**
