RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Tax Credit Reform Commission

3 For the purpose of extending the reporting date for the Tax Credit Reform Commission to make
4 recommendations and submit a final report.

5 WHEREAS, the Prince George’s County Council on February 27, 2018 adopted CR-9-
6 2018, establishing the Tax Credit Reform Commission (the “Commission”), a seventeen (17)
7 member group to review and analyze all the existing and proposed tax credits in the County to
8 determine the tax credit’s effectiveness, utilization, and efficacy in the County; and to
9 recommend reform of the tax credit policy based on their review and deliberations; and to
10 present its findings and recommendations to the County Council on or before June 1, 2018; and

11 WHEREAS, the County Council desires to provide additional time to the Commission to
12 ensure that the Commission has the time it needs to process the significant amount of
13 information it has gathered; and

14 WHEREAS, Section 506 of the Charter provides that the County Council may appoint, for
15 designated periods, one or more temporary advisory boards of citizens of the County who shall
16 assist in the consideration of County policies and programs.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
18 County, Maryland, that the Commission’s original June 1, 2018 final report deadline is extended
19 for submission on or before October 1, 2018.
