Sec. 10-317. Fund established.				
There is a non-lapsing Video Lottery Facility Local Impact Grant Special Revenue Fund				
("the Fund").				
Sec. 10-318. Purposes and uses.				
The revenue paid into the Fund shall be dedicated to and appropriated only for those				

purposes set forth in the Annotated Code of Maryland, State Government Article, Sec. 9-1A-31. Sec. 10-319. Financing the Fund. The Fund shall be financed from the revenue generated from the local impact grant distributed to the County pursuant to the Annotated Code of Maryland, State Government Article, Sec. 9-1A-27. General Fund revenues may be used to supplement appropriations from the Fund for the purposes set forth in the Annotated Code of Maryland, State Government Article, Sec. 9-1A-31. Sec. 10-320. Administration of the Fund. The Director of Finance or other designee of the County Executive shall administer the Fund according to accepted principles of sound accounting and fiscal management. Sec. 10-321. Reporting. The Chief Administrative Officer or other designee of the County Executive shall provide an annual report to the County Council and County Executive that details the activities, budget, and expenditures undertaken by the Fund on or before December 31st of each year. SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
