BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Video Lottery Facility Local Impact Grant Special Revenue Fund

3 For the purpose of establishing a Video Lottery Facility Local Impact Grant Special Revenue
4 Fund; specifying the purposes and uses of the Fund; providing for the financing and
5 administration of the Fund; and generally providing for the Fund.

6 BY adding:

7 SUBTITLE 10. FINANCE AND TAXATION.

8 Sections 10-317, 10-318, 10-319, 10-320, and 10-321,

9 The Prince George's County Code

10 (2015 Edition; 2016 Supplement).

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
12 Maryland, that Sections 10-317, 10-318, 10-319, 10-320 and 10-321 of the Prince George's
13 County Code be and the same are hereby added:

14 SUBTITLE 10. FINANCE AND TAXATION.

15 **DIVISION 25. VIDEO LOTTERY FACILITY LOCAL IMPACT GRANT SPECIAL**
16 **REVENUE FUND.**

17 **Sec. 10-317. Fund established.**

18 There is a non-lapsing Video Lottery Facility Local Impact Grant Special Revenue Fund
19 (“the Fund”).

20 **Sec. 10-318. Purposes and uses.**

21 The revenue paid into the Fund shall be dedicated to and appropriated only for those

1 purposes set forth in the Annotated Code of Maryland, State Government Article, Sec. 9-1A-31.

2 **Sec. 10-319. Financing the Fund.**

3 The Fund shall be financed from the revenue generated from the local impact grant
4 distributed to the County pursuant to the Annotated Code of Maryland, State Government
5 Article, Sec. 9-1A-27. General Fund revenues may be used to supplement appropriations from
6 the Fund for the purposes set forth in the Annotated Code of Maryland, State Government
7 Article, Sec. 9-1A-31.

8 **Sec. 10-320. Administration of the Fund.**

9 The Director of Finance or other designee of the County Executive shall administer the
10 Fund according to accepted principles of sound accounting and fiscal management.

11 **Sec. 10-321. Reporting.**

12 The Chief Administrative Officer or other designee of the County Executive shall provide
13 an annual report to the County Council and County Executive that details the activities, budget,
14 and expenditures undertaken by the Fund on or before December 31st of each year.

15 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)
16 calendar days after it becomes law.
