The Office of Law has reviewed the above referenced bill as it was presented on April 18, 2017, and offer the following comments:

Page 2, Ln 3: Per Section 813 of the Charter, Registry fees may be subject to referendum.

<u>Page 2, Lines 9-10:</u> Section 10-202 of the Local Government Article caps civil fines at \$1,000.

Page 2, Lines 12-13: The authority to impose a tax lien on a property must comes from the State of Maryland. At this time, it is unclear as to the authority that the County has to impose a tax lien as proposed in this bill.
