## RESOLUTION

## A RESOLUTION concerning

Compensation of the Chairman of the Prince George's County
Planning Board

For the purpose of establishing and providing for the compensation of the Chairman of the Prince George's County Planning Board.

WHEREAS, Article 28, Section 2-104 of the Annotated Code of Maryland governs the compensation of members of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, upon recommendation from the County Executive, the County Council may authorize whatever supplementary compensation as may be deemed appropriate for the Chairman of the Prince George's County Planning Board, designated to serve on a full-time basis; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has designated Elizabeth M. Hewlett to serve as Chairman of the Prince George's County Planning Board on a full-time basis and has recommended the compensation for that position; now, therefore, SECTION 1. BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the supplementary salary for Elizabeth M. Hewlett, as full-time Chairman of the Prince George's County Planning Board, be and the same is hereby established in the amount of \$86,400.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the salary of the full-time Chairman of the Prince George's County Planning Board shall be adjusted annually in the amount equal to 75% of the change in the Consumer Price Index for all urban consumers in the Washington,

D.C. area for the period of March to March. The annual adjustment shall be effective each year on June 15th.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Elizabeth M. Hewlett, in addition to salary, shall continue to be entitled to the fringe benefits for full-time employees of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission, shall retain her accumulated leave balances, and shall accrue annual leave on the basis of thirty (30) days per year.
