BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT**(Includes reason for proposal, as well as any unique statutory requirements)**

The bill proposes repeal of Section 307A of the Charter, which provides that the County Executive and members of the County Council may not serve more than two consecutive terms. If approved by two-thirds of the Council, the bill must be submitted to the voters for their approval in the November 2000 General Election.
