This resolution will amend the County Procurement Regulations to implement the amendments of Section 10A-101 of the County Code to add Native Americans to the definition of minority individuals and refine the definitions of certain groups identified in the definition of minority individuals. During discussion of the resolution and CB-43-2011, there was a question as to when Native Americans were removed from the groups listed under minority individuals. Roland Jones, Executive Director of the Minority Business Development Division in the Office of Central Services stated the group was taken out in the early 1990s.

The Office of Law has reviewed this legislation and finds it to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its adoption.
